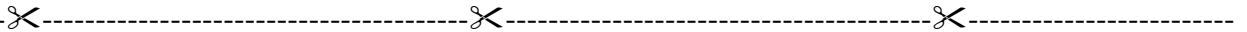

We are a local Christian organization that presents a message of freedom from homosexual desire and behavior. We offer support to individuals, churches, and those facing the reality of a homosexual friend or family member.

We are a non-profit, interdenominational ministry, serving the Central Willamette Valley (Albany, Corvallis, Eugene, and Salem). We are not a mental health facility. Instead our methodology utilizes personal testimonies, trained lay counseling, Biblical instruction, and spiritually oriented accountability groups.

We offer a choice to those who struggle with sexual identity issues. We support no political agendas or candidates. We firmly believe that sexual and relational redemption is available for all who seek it.

Mid-Valley Fellowship focuses on two primary areas in ministry: Support and Communication

Through both avenues we endeavor to share a message of hope with those impacted by homosexuality.

Individual Support

We offer pastoral counseling for men and women struggling with same-sex attraction. A confidential conversation is a safe place to initiate a process of growth and explore the options available.

Taking Back Ground

This two-year discipleship and support program is for men and women seeking to heal from sexual and relational brokenness. It equips those struggling with same-sex attraction by providing tools to walk a victorious life.

Family & Friends

Many difficult issues arise when a family member or friend is embracing homosexuality. We offer support and encouragement along with practical feedback about your specific situation.

Homosexuality 101

An interactive three-part curriculum, intended to fit into a Sunday School or Small Group format. The focus is to educate, give practical advice, and answer questions on this complex and confusing topic.

Speaking

Through sharing our stories of redemption with your church, youth group, college, or other group, we present a picture of God working in individuals' lives, no matter what their issue.

Newsletter
