We are a local Christian organization that presents a message of hope and healing for those struggling with sexual brokenness. We minister to individuals, churches, and those facing the reality of a spouse, family member, or friend impacted by sexual brokenness.

We are a non-profit, interdenominational ministry, serving the Central Willamette Valley (Albany, Corvallis, Eugene, and Salem). We are not a mental health facility. Instead our methodology utilizes personal testimonies, trained lay counseling, Biblical instruction, and Christ-centered accountability groups.

We offer a choice to those who struggle with sexual identity issues and addictive behaviors. We support no political agendas or candidates. We firmly believe that sexual and relational redemption is available for all who seek it.

Support

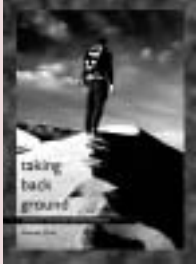
Individual Support

We offer pastoral counseling for men and women struggling with sexual brokenness. A confidential conversation is a safe place to initiate a process of growth and explore the options available.



Clean Heart

These small groups support those struggling with pornography or sexual addiction, in a safe, confidential environment. Through accountability, education, and prayer, participants are equipped with tools to walk in victory.



Taking Back Ground

This two-year discipleship and support program is for men and women seeking to heal from sexual and relational brokenness. It equips those struggling with unwanted homosexual desires by providing tools to walk a victorious life.



Spouses/Family/Friends

Many difficult issues arise when a spouse, family member, or friend is impacted by sexual brokenness. We offer support and encouragement along with practical feedback about your specific situation.

Communication

Many in the Church do not hear a hope-filled, redemptive message about sexual brokenness (homosexuality, pornography, sexual addiction), so we desire to share that message, with a focus on God's power to change lives.



Personal Testimony

Through sharing our stories of redemption with your church, youth group, college, or other group, we present a picture of God working in individuals' lives, no matter what their issue.



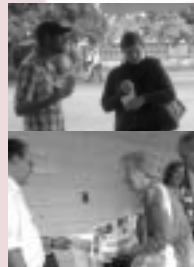
Newsletter
