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Who is Mid-Valley Fellowship?

There are many voices in our world that speak messages about homosexuality, pornography, and sexual addiction that are in conflict with God's creative intent for humanity. Even in the Church community, we are uncertain how to react.

For those struggling with sexual brokenness, a sense of confusion and hopelessness can easily take root.

Mid-Valley Fellowship exists to walk alongside those struggling and educate the Church, while reflecting God's grace, truth, and incredible power to change lives.

Mid-Valley Fellowship is a non-profit, interdenominational ministry, serving the Central Willamette Valley (Albany, Corvallis, Eugene, and Salem).

We are not a mental health facility. Instead, our methodology utilizes personal testimonies, trained lay counseling, Biblical instruction, and Christ-centered accountability groups.

What is Change for Change?

Change for Change is a simple way your church can support those struggling with sexual brokenness! Change for Change banks are designed to be taken home by people in your church and filled with coins, dollar bills, or checks.

After a few weeks, they are brought back to the church and collected.

The proceeds help pay for participant scholarships, program and counseling fees, and support the ministry of Mid-Valley Fellowship!

How does it work?

Pre-Campaign:

- Decide on the dates for your campaign and schedule it with MVF.
- Select a Church Coordinator to be our primary point of contact.
- Schedule the pick-up or delivery of materials from MVF.

Week 1: ___/___/___

- Show promotional video to church.
- Distribute Change for Change banks.
- Coordinator collects participant information.

Week 2: ___/___/___

- Re-emphasize Change for Change, using announcement slide provided.
- Show promotional video again if desired.

Week 3 & 4: ___/___/___

- Continue to show announcement slide.

Week 5: ___/___/___

- Reminder to return banks next week.

Week 6: ___/___/___

- Announcement reminder/collection begins.
- Coordinator follows up with people who forgot to bring back their bank.

Post-Campaign:

- Coordinator collects all banks.
- MVF is contacted to schedule pick-up or return of materials and banks.
- A summary of the campaign is given to the Church Coordinator.
