- Leading table conversation among your guests on the night of the dinner.

Tips on Finding Guests

Sometimes figuring out who to invite to the Benefit Dinner can be a challenge. However, we all have various spheres of relationship in which we engage on a weekly or even daily basis. Consider these groups of individuals and whether there are people in each group that might be good to invite. Pray into each sphere you're a part of, and see if God brings anyone to mind.

- family members in the area, including extended family
- neighbors
- people who have invited you to a benefit dinner for another organization
- fellow members of groups in the community (other school parents, athletic teams, fraternal clubs)
